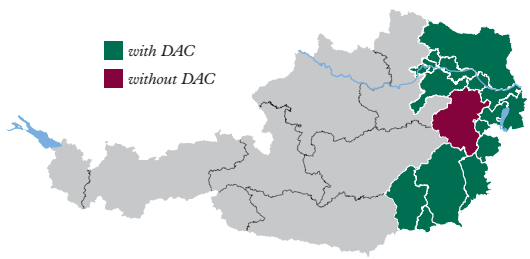
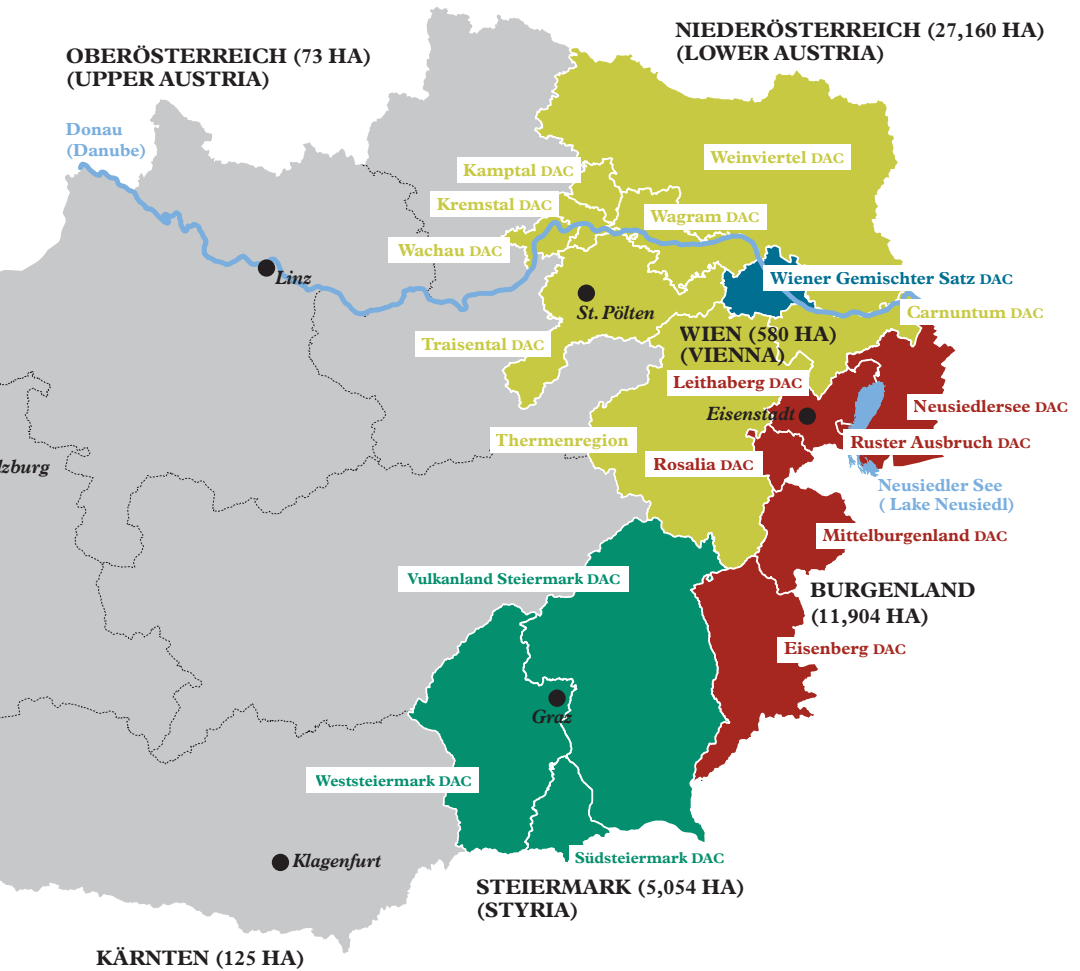

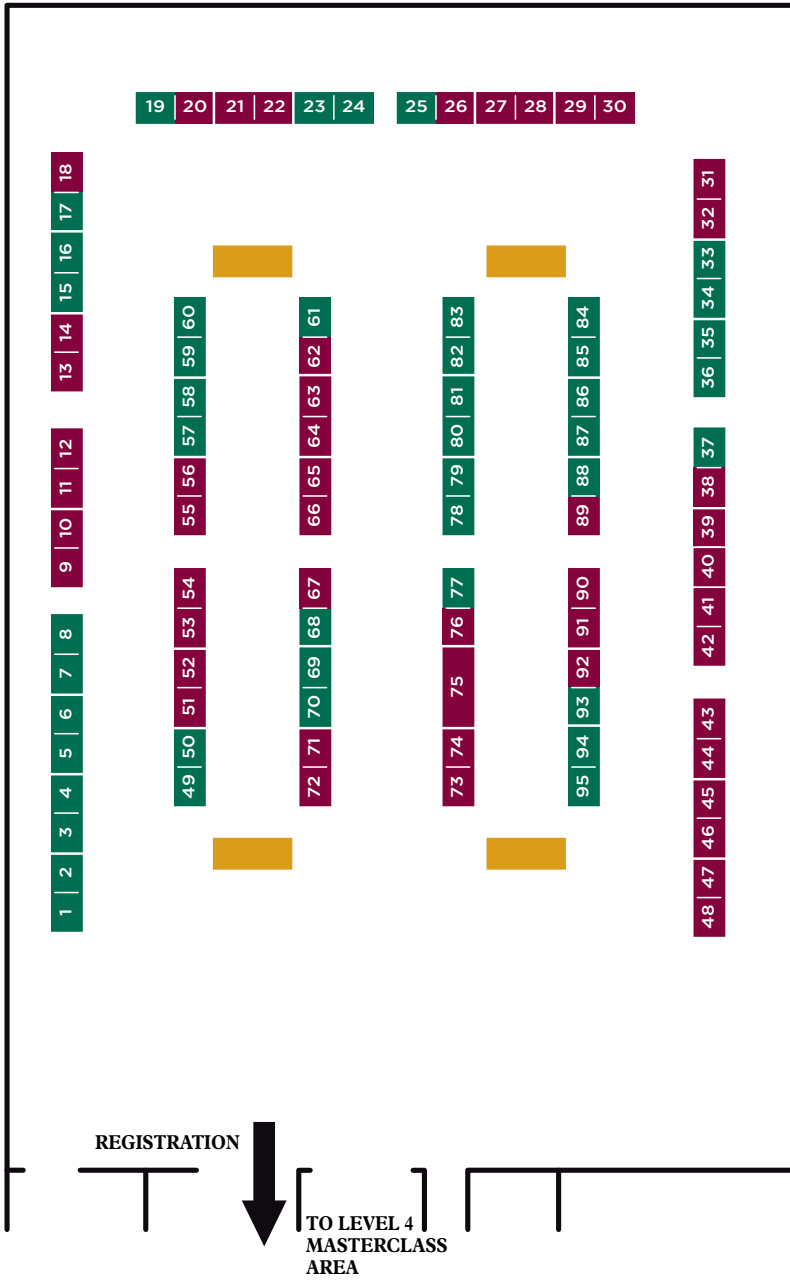

Type 1: Perlweine & Sekte

Austria can look back on a venerable tradition of sparkling wine, one that dates back to the 19th century. Our specialists in the sparkling sector include private producers, as well as large Sekt houses. Whether Sekt Austria (PDO) of the basic category or the traditionally vinified pétillant naturel (Pét Nat), these wines are ideally suited not only to the classic role of apéritif but also prove their versatility as dinner-table companions. Fruit and refreshment share the foreground in these easily drinkable light sparklers (Perlwein) and Sekts.

Type 2: Sekt Méthode Traditionelle

Traditional bottle fermentation is the most time-consuming and costly process for making sparkling wine: it takes a lot of time, and the typical ‘riddling’ of the bottles during ageing is often performed by hand. Austria’s top products – especially Sekt Austria (PDO) Reserve and Grosse Reserve – are produced according to this method. The result turns out as characterful and highly elegant Sekts, which do not need to fear any international comparisons.

Type 3: White wines - classic & refreshing

Classic white wines from Austria get top marks for their freshness and fine acidity – which they combine with considerable elegance in a middleweight frame. These can be found in all our winegrowing regions: refreshing and regionally typical Grüner Veltliner & Riesling from the regions along the Danube River, peppery Weinviertel DAC, delicious Wiener Gemischter Satz DAC, classic Weissburgunder & Chardonnay from Burgenland or spicy Welschriesling & Sauvignon Blanc from the Steiermark. Youthful wines such as Junger Österreicher, Steierischer Junker or Junger Wiener are the first to appear on the calendar in the classic & refreshing category, and can be tasted soon after the harvest.

Type 4: White wines - powerful & opulent

These stars of Austrian white wine culture are vinified dry, exhibiting body and extract, opulence and concentration. In addition to the majority of classically elaborated wines, here you will also find wines matured in barrique with a bit of an international accent. Among the elite one finds single-vineyard wines vinified from Grüner Veltliner and Riesling (like Smaragd bottlings from the Wachau), and top wines from regions along the Danube or from the Weinviertel. Other very distinctive vinous personalities include robust Zierfandler and Rotgipfler from the Thermenregion, as well as complex Weissburgunder and Chardonnay from Burgenland. This category is rounded out by the great single vineyard wines from the Steiermark (Sauvignon Blanc, Morillon, Weissburgunder & Grauburgunder), as well as specialties such as Neuburger, Roter Veltliner and the Gemischter Satz from Vienna.

Type 5: Rosé wines

Rosés are produced in all winegrowing regions of Austria and assume many forms: charming, youthful wines from Burgenland, or fresh stylings vinified from Zweigelt and Sankt Laurent in Niederösterreich, all the way to racy Schilcher from the Weststeiermark (some designated as a regionally protected Weststeiermark DAC). Burgenland also has its own protected appellation of origin for fruity-fresh and spicy rosé wine: Rosalia DAC Rosé.

Type 6: Red wines - classic & elegant

Red wines in the classic style – with *élevage* either in large wooden cask or steel tank, with typical Austrian fruit but also plenty of depth, without being too high in alcohol – which express the typicity of their origins, with elegance and an inviting nature. Zweigelt plays an important role, since it grows quite happily in almost all viticultural regions – though Carnuntum comes up first here – and classically vinified Blaufränkisch can also be convincingly distinctive. This group is rounded out by specialties such as Sankt Laurent, Blauburgunder (Pinot Noir), Blauer Portugieser & Blauburger.

Type 7: Red wines - intense & opulent

These are red wines that possess opulence, concentration, complexity and depth, vinified either as single varietal wines or as *cuvées*. Even with aging in *barriques*, these top wines are characterised by the typical depth of fruit characteristic of their *terroir*. The premiere destination for red wines of this sort is Burgenland – although top red wines can also be found coming from Carnuntum, the Thermenregion or even Vienna. It is satisfying to note that our typical Austrian grape varieties such as Blaufränkisch & Zweigelt might even do just a bit better here than classics like Pinot Noir and the international varieties Cabernet & Co.

Type 8: Alternative wines

A precise definition of ‘Orange Wines’, ‘Artisan Wines’ or ‘Natural’ wines – often referred to collectively as ‘Alternative Wines’, does not exist. What they have in common, however, is that they often develop as far as possible without human intervention during their process of becoming wine. Owing to oxidative development and/or extended maceration time, the white wines will also develop a distinct tannin structure – and even some colour from the skins – in combination with fresh acidity and earthy fruit. Growers who produce exceptional wines in these new – or actually old – ways can be found in all of Austria’s winegrowing regions.

Type 9: White wines - off-dry & medium-sweet

Wines in the upper Spätlese or Auslese class rank among the most ageworthy wines in Austria. In their youth they exhibit a great deal of *finesse*, combined with supple residual sweetness and a lively interplay between fruit and acidity. The palette ranges from Muskat Ottonel or Welschriesling from Burgenland, via (Gewürz)Traminer from the Steiermark, Grüner Veltliner and Riesling from various winegrowing regions, to the great Spätlesen or Auslesen vinified from the specialty varieties Zierfandler and Rotgipfler in the Thermenregion.

Type 10: Nobly sweet wines

These include Beerenauslese and Trockenbeerenauslese, as well as the classy and refined Ruster Ausbruch. These rare sweet wines are characterised by ample residual sugar and highly concentrated acidity, usually in conjunction with the distinctive aroma of noble rot (*Botrytis cinerea*). Such wines continue to develop in an exciting way over a long period of time and have great ageing potential – and Austria plays here in the Champions League. Eiswein with expressive, luxuriant fruit and sizzling acidity – as well as Strohwein and Schilfwein, which exhibit flavour profiles between *Botrytis* and Eiswein – also belong to this category.

Bründlmayer manages vineyards in the best locations around Langenlois. All of the vineyards have been cultivated sustainably since 1979 and in a biological-organic fashion since 2015. Among the Grüner Veltliners are stars like "Loiserberg", "Lamm" and "Käferberg". Among the Rieslings "Steinmassl" competes with the elegantly structured "Heiligenstein". The "Alte Reben" and "Lyra" of the Heiligenstein embody terroir and concentration. Hugh Johnson quotes "Bründlmayer Brut" as "Austria's Best Sekt". Zweigelt, Pinot Noir and Chardonnay belongs to Bründlmayer's acclaimed specialities as well as the rare sweet wines. "Almost every wine, from the lightest Grüner Veltliner to the red wine and the sparkling wine has what it takes to be the best of the vintage in its category." (Falstaff)

The Wetzeli winery is located in one of the most exciting wine-growing regions in Austria. Langenlois in the Kamptal is not only geologically very diverse, climatically it is also at the intersection of different zones of influence.

30 hectares of vineyards are cultivated according to biodynamic principles. Handicraft is very important to the winemaker Davis Wetzeli.

Terroir wines are aged in the cellar for at least 3 years to give them stability and longevity. They are only released when they have reached their first peak of maturity. Wines full of character with a high enjoyment factor are the result of the work.

The winery is in the process of converting to biodynamics according to Demeter guidelines and the wines are certified organic and vegan.

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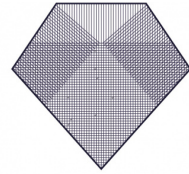

The Hajszan Neumann winery is located in Vienna's most famous wine-growing district,

Grinzing, at the foot of the Nussberg. Much passion is invested in certified biodynamic viticulture to yield elegant, unadulterated wines with authentic expression. Fritz Wieninger, pioneer of quality wine production Vienna took over management of this winery in 2014 where he concentrated on the production of Wiener Gemischter Satz, Riesling and Grüner Veltliner. The vineyards, most of which are owned by the star architect Heinz Neumann, are located in the best sites of Vienna with the Nussberg playing the leading role. The mineral-rich marine limestone and weathered calcareous soils impart wine expressive character.

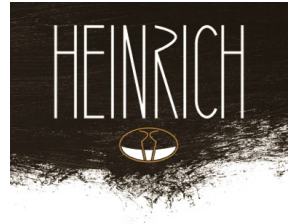

From these two varieties the whole spectrum from light, fresh-fruity wines and DACs to single vineyard and reserve wines is vinified. A cuvee of Chardonnay and Pinot Blanc and in very good vintages a wine of the grape variety Viognier complete the assortment.

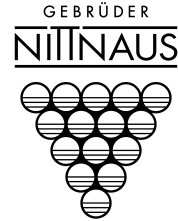

That's exactly where it got me, the bubble virus.

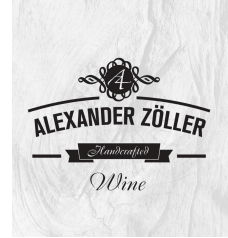

What happens if a young university graduant from Salzburg decides to grow wine in Lower Austria? To figure it out people should have a look at Dross, a little village some hills behind Krems where Alexander Zöller invested his saving in 16 Ar (half an acre) of vineyards. A year later another 1,5 ha were added - 70 years old vines which he also used to graft new vines and in 2007 he was already the proud owner of 3,2 hectares, an old vaulted cellar and some used wooden casks.

The beginning was not easy. His unrestrained enthusiasm met meteorological realities more expectable in Salzburg than in Dross. Hail (2007) and constant rains (2008) did not fail to affect him but were not able to throw him off course. He continued to produce wine which should convey its origin and natural precondi

“Typically Austrian top quality that carries my signature: my wines are charming and demanding at the same time – sometimes even a little bit cheeky. The whites are fermented and aged in stainless steel.

They are left on the lees for quite a while, thus obtaining the stability for their long aging potential.“

“Summer – sun, rain, and temperature variations: The weather calls the tune. The more the vines are used to being self-sustaining, the more tolerant they react to weather influences. To strengthen them, I rely on forming a dense humus layer that helps equalize the water balance. What is also crucial to me is a nutrient supply to the vines as independent as possible. For that, I support the vines by a sophisticated concept of pruning and canopy management.

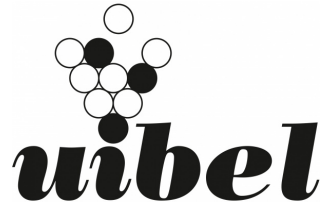

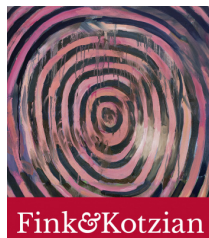

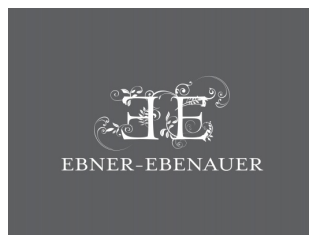

Franz-Josef Wutzl, the winemaker, feels the vocation to make puristic top-wines under environmental-friendly conditions. After all, a vital fauna and flora in the vineyards is the fundament of a successful winery. In the wine cellar the interference into the development of the wines is kept to a minimum. This leads to very authentic wines which are closely linked to the characteristic of the respective vineyard sites.

Their vineyards, located at the slopes of the Eisenberg mountain, are facing south-east and benefit from the hot and dry climate and the mineral-rich soils of the region, where the Blaufränkischer grapes have been cultivated since the late 18th century. The red wine is full-bodied and aromatic, with a pronounced mineral taste.

The Kopfensteiner family's winemaking tradition ensures that their red wines are characteristically fruity and dark colored. The estate's top wine, the "Border", is a blend (cuvée) of Blaufränkisch and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, but the main part of the wine production is based on the Blaufränkischer.

We have started with 600 vines in 2009 and extended our vineyard in the meanwhile to 21.000 vines and 4.5ha. Our vineyard is operated Biodynamic and Organic.

Our family does winegrowing since the beginning of the 20th century. Mr. Anton Iby (Anton 3 rd) produced wines after the second world war, but only bulk wine for traders. At that time the quality-level was very low in Austria.

Mr. Anton (Anton 4 th) and Mrs. Johanna Iby build up a winery since 1983 and started winegrowing with 1.4 hectares of vineyards for high quality production. A story of success and hard work began. In 1986 our winery began receiving national awards for the high quality and so Mr. Anton Iby was one of the important people for developing better practices for quality production in our region. The austrian wine-scandal was the birth of a new way of thinking about winemaking and so the Blaufränkischland changed into the red heart of Austria.
