






AUSTRIAN WINE EXPORTS: BOTTLE VS. BULK





- Illyrian Mediterranean climate




AUSTRIA IS STILL A COOL CLIMATE WINE-GROWING COUNTRY, BUT...

- +2°C average temperature since 1980
- Hotter summers, less snow in winter, receding glaciers
- Danger: drought, floods, hail, mudslides, late frost (2016) ...
- Diseases: pests survive the winter much easier nowadays
- Higher altitude vineyards gain interest
- Resistant grape varieties gain interest



ENVIRONMENTAL CONSCIOUSNESS

- Austria's agricultural sector 27% organic
- Organic vineyard share rose from 3% to 15,3% (6.976 hectares based on INVEKOS) within 15 years – thereof almost one fifth (1,433 hectares) farmed biodynamically
- 873 organic winegrowers
- 19.7% (8.808 ha) of vineyards are certified sustainable (Sustainable Austria)
- Maximum yield 10,000 kg/ha
- Hand harvest still dominant



PERFORMANCE WITH AWARENESS



The "Sustainable Austria" certification programme regulates the use of the term "sustainability" in Austrian winemaking.



Wines made organically or biodynamically can be identified by the green EU organic logo with the code number of the certification body.





THE GREATEST VALUES IN FINE WINE

- Austria leaves the lowest entry level
- Not cheap but excellent value for money
- Top wines from 10 20 €
- World class available from 30 €
 - California, Burgundy, etc.: from 120 €




QUALITÄTSWEIN

- Grapes harvested in a single winegrowing region
- From grape varieties, approved for Qualitätswein
- Minimum must weight 15 °KMW
- Federal Inspection Number after sensorial examination
- Min. alcohol 9.0%
- Total acidity min. 4 g/l
- Maximum yield 10,000 kg grapes/ha
- Free of defects in appearance, smell and flavour






AUSTRIAN WINEGROWING REGIONS

FROM VINTAGE 2022: 17 DAC ORIGINS




DAC: DISTRICTUS AUSTRIAE CONTROLLATUS



WINE HIERARCHY & PRICE PYRAMID




OFFICIAL VINEYARD MAPPING


- 2018 2021: Legal definition/mapping of all Austrian vineyards, municipality by municipality
- All single vineyard wines must carry the word "Ried" ahead of the name of the single vineyard
- No official vineyard classification so far
- Definition of all villages that can appear on a label for "villages" wine (Ortswein)
- Austrianvineyards.com: world's first digital wine atlas on a legal basis covering an entire wine-producing country




